Faculty ensure that candidates have the knowledge, skills, and dispositions to achieve the EEDA performance standards in the Teacher Education Program and that they can implement these standards once they begin teaching. While EEDA is covered and assessed in several classes the main place where EEDA is addressed heavily is in EDU341 Elementary Classroom Environment and in EDU342 Secondary Classroom Environment. A review of the syllabi for these courses indicates that learning styles, cooperative learning, contextual teaching and learning, and character education are all covered in these two classes. In addition, the three performance standards related to career development are covered and assessed in the methods classes.
