• The unit aligns degree programs, professional development courses, and related activities for teachers and other school personnel with the most recent National Educational Technology Standards (NETS-T) developed by the International Society for Technology in Education (ISTE) as a strategy for significantly enhancing the capacity of preservice as well as in-service teachers to incorporate technology into their teaching and their students' leaning.

Description of Success

The Newberry College Teacher Education Program requires all the candidates take a course entitled EDU382, Integrating Technology into Teaching. In this course the ISTE standards are addressed and are linked to the program learning outcomes and student learning outcomes from the course. The syllabus provided as evidence does not use the newest version of the ISTE standards which were recently passed. Faculty members are working over the summer to connect EDU382 course content to the newest ISTE standards. Newberry College does not offer professional development courses or technology activities for teachers and other school personnel at this time. The only part of the standard that pertains to this program is in the alignment with the undergraduate teacher education degrees.
